

Horizon Replaces Bell 206 Jet Ranger and Agusta Bell 206 with Bell 505, Further Enhancing Flight Training

Dubai-UAE: 17 November, 2019 - Horizon, the Middle East's largest independent [helicopter flight training academy](#) supporting commercial and military operators, today announced its decision to replace the Bell 206 Jet Ranger and the Agusta Bell 206 with the [Bell 505 helicopter](#).

The announcement was made on the sidelines of the Dubai Airshow 2019, which is taking place at Dubai World Central from 17 - 21 November. Horizon's initiative contributes to the market demand for glass cockpit [helicopter training](#), while meeting the latest technology training needs.

The new Bell 505 aircraft come equipped with integrated glass cockpits and increased automation, among other features that are expected to reduce overall pilot workload whilst simultaneously providing unparalleled crew situational awareness.

The integration of the Bell 505 into the fleet further reinforces the Academy's mission of delivering the latest innovative training solutions."
